In either case the parents had to pay for the teaching and the books, and children who did not learn well were severely punished. You see that when Goody Two Shoes began to teach the little children in her free, pleasant way, they had a much happier time than if they had gone to the usual school. No wonder they and their mothers liked her so much. It would be fun, indeed, to be helped through the lessons by all the intelligent pets that flocked around Margery. That was the kind of school that Goldsmith himself would have liked when he was a little boy.
